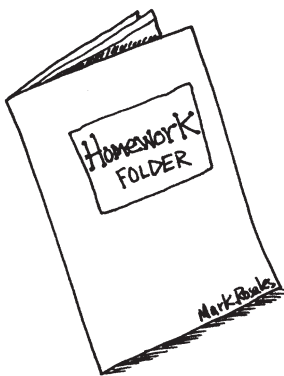
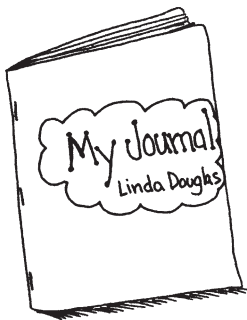
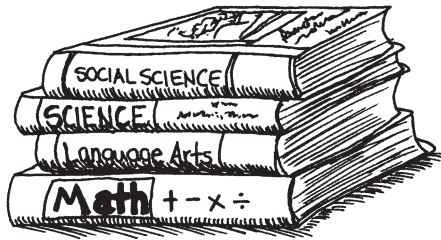
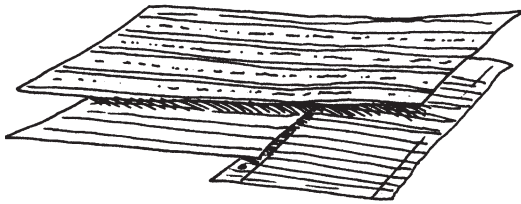
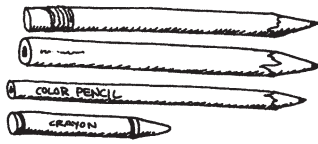
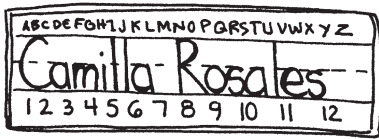


First Day Student Checklist

Textbooks

- Textbooks numbered for inventory purposes
- Textbooks assigned to individual students
- Textbooks for all curricular areas
- Reading textbook, including consumable books
- Math textbook, including consumable books
- Science textbook, including consumable books
- Social Science textbook, including consumable books

Journals

- One per student per subject area
- Provided by school or created by the student
- Journal writing to be modeled to whole class

Homework Folders

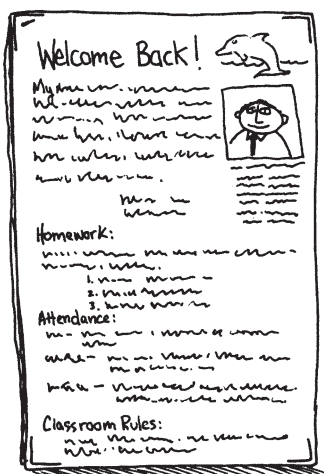
- Folders for tracking homework and home communications from the school

- Decorated by the student
- Optional cover with grade-appropriate learning tools (alphabet, multiplication table, etc.)
